I would like to ask each local president to:

- Create a talent pool using the Talent Bank form to be shared with the District Membership Nurture and Outreach Coordinator (MNO), Nomination Chair and District Secretary. When the District realignment is completed, this information will be very helpful to build a strong team.

- Plan a Pledge Service in early 2024 (January or February) to raise your Mission Pledge for 2025. This service should not concentrate on the mission giving, but the reason we give and how the funds are used to support the Purpose of UWF. I am reminded of the bold gift given by the poor widow in Mark 12:41-44, "May we also be bold in our pledge commitment." Have Pledge Cards completed by all who are willingly to support the work of UWF. The District Treasurer will be asked to give the District Pledge to Mission for 2025 in June/July 2024, therefore she will need this information from each local organization in May/June 2024 to compile and have ready for the Conference Treasurer.
